



NOTICE ON CUSTOMS CRITICAL CARGO ACTIVITIES
FREE ZONE AUTHORITY, PORT KLANG FREE ZONE (PKFZ)

Pursuant to the directive from Port Klang Authority ("PKA") in regards to the implementation for Customs Critical Goods (*Rokok dan Minuman Keras "RMK"*), kindly take note of the following enhancement of the control mechanism which will come into force as specified below:-

i) NEW OPERATION HOURS FOR "RMK" OPERATORS/WAREHOUSES.

The new operating hours for the RMK cargo movement is between 0800 and 1900 with effect from 1 May 2019.

ii) RESTRICTION ON RMK GOODS TRANSFER TO UNLICENSED OPERATORS.

- a) RMK goods transfers between warehouses at PKFZ (ZB4A) is allowed only when both parties (sender & recipient) have a valid import license issued by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD).
- b) With immediate effect, unlicensed operators are not allowed to receive, accept, store, keep or transfer any RMK goods.

iii) REAL-TIME STOCK REPORT.

Real-time stock report will be implemented on 1 June 2019 and the operator would not able to generate the gate pass if the stock report is not current and up to date.

iv) INSPECTION AND ESCORT OF RMK GOODS.

Port police escort and inspection is mandatory for RMK goods with effect from 1 June 2019. You may obtain the standard operating procedures from the PKFZ's security department.
